Night Time Economy Enforcement

Purpose	<p>Reduction of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anti-Social Behaviour and • the Fear of Crime <p>associated with late-night operation of Licensed Premises through the provision of an improved Out-of-Hours Response Service in the City. Although there is currently an Out of Hours Service provided by Environmental Health Officers, the purpose of this project is to identify non compliant premises and investigate complaints outside of the hours for which this Service is currently provided. The involvement of other Enforcement Officers will extend the scope of legislation covered.</p>
Activities and Personnel	<p><u>Street Enforcement Officers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor street activity arising from licensed premises • React to complaints of street noisy in partnership with CoL Police • Deal with unlicensed activities on the public highway – e.g. mini cabs, street vendors, etc. • Liaise with / hand-over to the most appropriate regulatory authority <p><u>Licensing Team</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor compliance with Licensing conditions during hours of operation • Sales of alcohol to persons who appear inebriated <p><u>Trading Standards Team</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age Restricted Sales – alcohol and tobacco to minors <p><u>Environmental Health Officers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investigate noise complaints associated with Licensed premises
