Comments:

1. The under spend has been reduced by £55K to adjust for unspent carry forward monies from 2008/09 in relation to the vacancy factor at Tower Bridge Operational.

- 2. The overspend has been increased by £9.5K to adjust for unspent carry forward monies from 2008/09. This related to savings on 2 electric vehicles purchased and the BACAS system implementation at the Cemetery.
- 3. The under spend has been reduced by £43K to adjust for unspent carry forward monies from 2008/09 relating to an unused income subsidy at the Monument that was not required due to exceptional performance in visitor numbers in 2009/10, plus a further £183.3K operating surplus was transferred to the Tower Bridge Designated Reserve Fund. A balance of £279K specifically for Tower Bridge Tourism remains as an under spend to complete various carry forward projects in 2010/11.
- 4. The outturn performance including detailed explanations of budget variances for each individual Division of Service reporting to the various receiving Committee's is explained in detail within the Chamberlain's 2009/10 budget outturn report. This report will be included in each receiving Committee's July cycle of committee papers.
