Short term:

65% reduction in
KSIs by 2022
against the
2005-09 baseline

Medium term:

70% reduction in
KSIs by 2030
against the new
2010-14 baseline

Long term:

Zero KSIs by
2041

Bus casualty targets:

1. 70% reduction in KSIs in, or by, buses by 2022 against 2005-09 baseline
2. No one killed in, or by, a bus by 2030

Northbound 1990

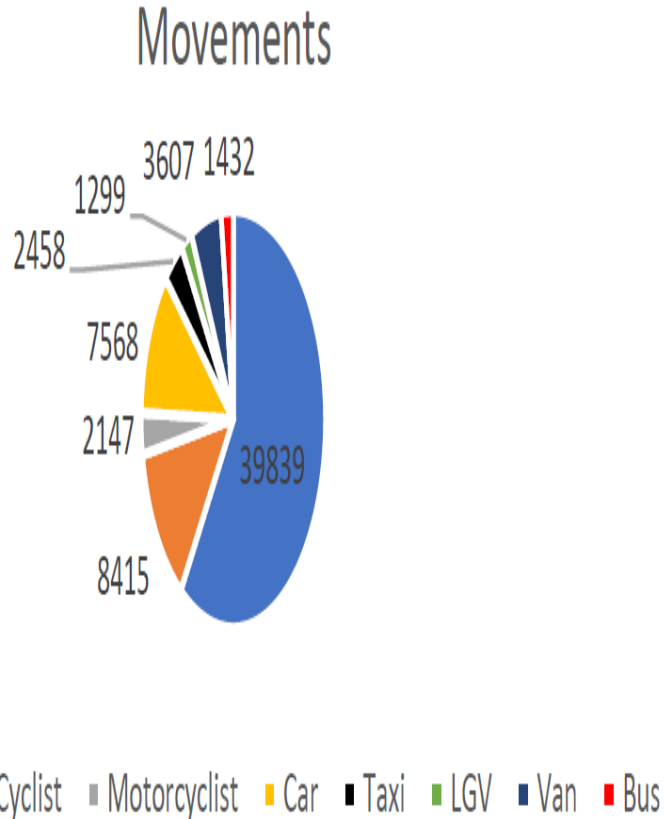
Evening Peak (16:00 – 19:00)

Finding the right safety solution

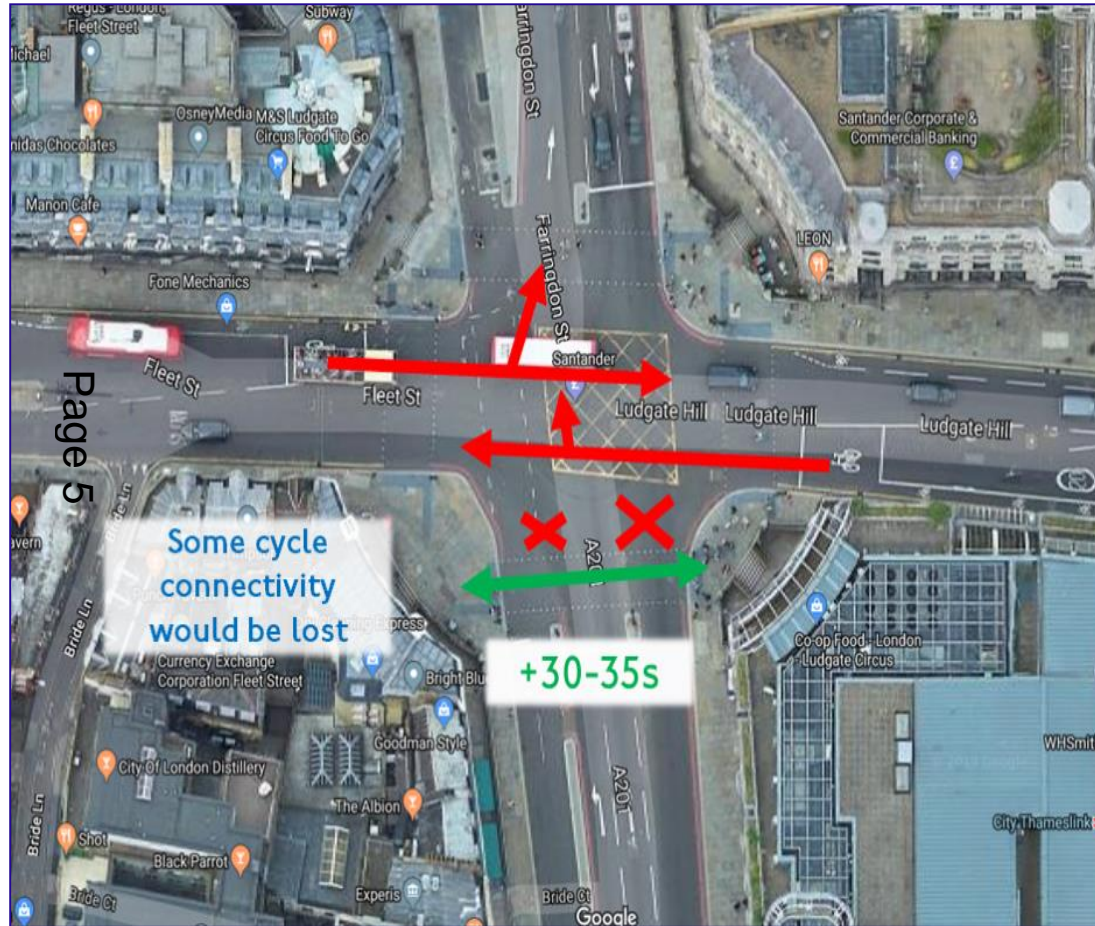

- Collective partnership between TfL and the City of London
- Recognising the importance of reducing waiting time for pedestrians as much as possible
- Changing the signal timings to encourage pedestrians to cross safely



Our proposals to improve road safety at Ludgate Circus



- Restricting turning movements could make a real difference to the pedestrian crossing experience.
- Removing east-west movements turning south into New Bridge Street would allow one of the most critical crossings to run in parallel with traffic and remove traffic from this bus corridor.



Our proposals to improve road safety at Ludgate Circus



- Diverted traffic from Ludgate Hill could travel to Blackfriars Bridge via Queen Victoria Street where there is spare green



Timescales for delivery of the new proposals



- Safety is always our number one priority
- We are currently going through that design process which when complete will go to our contractors for installation.
- We will aim to have these works completed within 3 months and will continue to update City officers and Members on progress
