- There are 17 Public Lifts/Escalators in the City of London estate. The report below contains details of the 5-public escalator/lifts that were working for less than 95% of the time.
- The report was created on 10th February 2020 and subsequently since this time the public lifts or escalators may have experienced further breakdowns which will be conveyed in the next report.
