their most sincere thanks for the distinguished way in which she has carried out the varied demands of the Office of Lord Mayor of the City of London over the past year.

She has been an exemplary ambassador for both the City of London and the United Kingdom, both at home and abroad, with diversity, sustainability, charity leadership and philanthropy the key themes of her year in Office. The "Power of Diversity" programme, which the Lord Mayor has championed since its launch in January, has now grown to encompass some 50 major employers. The legacy of this programme will serve to help identify and promote the steps that the City, at all management levels, must take to maximise the energy and innovation that diversity can bring to business. As Lord Mayor she has taken the opportunity to address a wide range of City organisations about the business case for diversity and inclusion and she has supported a number of initiatives which will help to enable a broader discussion, at all levels, about how organisations interact with their diverse workforces. Road safety

Alderman Ian Luder asked a question of the Chairman of the Planning and Transportation Committee concerning the steps the City of London Corporation was taking to improve road safety at Ludgate Circus junction. In reply, the Chairman highlighted some of the joint working with Transport for London which had been undertaken to-date to improve signage and safety at the junction and agreed that more must be done to improve safety for all road users.

In response to a supplementary question, the Chairman concurred that any improvements should be made in the interests of all road users rather than seeking to promote one group's interests ahead of another.
