Conditions consistent with Operating Schedule

- 1) The supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be limited to the service of alcoholic drinks to persons seated at tables outside the premises authorised for such use by the City of London Corporation.
- 2) The supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall cease at 21:00 hours each night.
- 3) The supply of alcohol shall be by waiter/waitress to patrons seated at tables or at the service counter.
- 4) The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the licensing authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
- 5) Promoted events will not be held at the premises. A promoted event is an event where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the premises licence holder and the event is (independent of the premises licence holder) promoted to the general public.
- 6) Notices shall be prominently displayed to remind patrons that they are leaving a premises with residential neighbours.
