Blackfriars Bridge SC6462771	OUT OF SERVICE	30.21%	3	439 hrs	24/09/2019 – Engineer attended site, found top floor landing and car doors forced open. Car door belt and both landing locks broken. Engineer made safe and left off for further works. Parts ordered and engineer returned on the 30/09/2019 where parts were fitted but a new processor fault was detected. Further parts required and are on order. Lift out of service at end of reporting period.
