Main Report

REQUEST FOR DECISION UNDER URGENCY - PUSH TO PLAY - CULTURE MILE

- 1. The Town Clerk, in consultation with the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of your Committee, ratified the City Arts Initiative's recommendations in relation to a proposal to approve the application of *Push to Play Culture Mile* at Smithfield Rotunda Garden.
- 2. Push to Play is an interactive installation, involving a large metal box with a button inviting audiences to press it. When the button is pressed, a receipt printer will generate a set of content which will be co-curated by play experts Made by Play and Culture Mile. The content encourages playful interactions with people and place.
- 3. The design and location were chosen following research and pilot sessions led by Made by Play and Culture Mile.
- 4. The installation is scheduled to be in place from 23 October to 22 November 2019 and will be funded by Culture Mile Programming.
- 5. Approval of the application is subject to final consent from the Highways and City Gardens Teams and implementation of the following recommendations:
 - The applicant's installation plans should factor in any potential disruption from the Animal Rebellion demonstration;
 - The applicant should adhere to relevant legislation that restricts the introduction of certain new structures in Smithfield Rotunda Gardens;
 - The applicant should ensure that any potential problems with littering are mitigated;
 - The applicant should adhere to any access or planning requirements;
 - The applicant should consult the City Gardens and Highways to ensure any additional necessary measures are put in place.
- 6. The matter was dealt with under urgency as installation was planned for 23 October 2019, prior to the Committee meeting.
