15526	Adoramus	2000.00	Funding is sought for the first public performance, at St. Sepulchre-without- Newgate, of a newly commissioned <i>Missa Brevis</i> by a large mixed choir and orchestra.
			The panel did not consider that this application sufficiently meets the outcomes of the Inspiring London through Culture programme and needed to prioritise projects that did. It was also felt that the costs of the concert could be considered prohibitive and not open to all.
15522	Bishopsgate Institute	10000.00	Funding is sought to run a programme of free lunchtime concerts at Bishopsgate Institute to enhance cultural provision in the area.
			The application did not demonstrate how it meets the outcome of the programme. The application did not demonstrate how it will attract new audiences, even after detailed feedback on a previously submitted proposal.

15530	London Euphonia Orchestra	10000.00	Continuation funding to cover the operational costs including rehearsal space, venue hire and marketing to deliver concerts in the City over the course of a year.
			The applicant has not done enough to demonstrate how the previous funding awarded by your committee has helped them to become financially sustainable. The panel agreed that they did not wish the organisation to become over reliant on your funding and feedback should be provided that any future application contains a match funding offer. The organisation will be invited to re-apply in January.
15521	Open Audio Ltd	4845.00	New music and poetry concert series providing rare access to the Bascule Chambers of Tower Bridge for younger audiences.  Although the application was deemed to be of a good quality it was not clear how the programme would target new audiences and more development of this would be required. The panel felt they could not prioritise this application at this time but would be happy to receive a more developed application in the future.
15528	St Stephen Walbrook	7500.00	To deliver a series of interactive school workshops in October/ November 2019, culminating in a pavilion inspired by the cultural heritage of St Stephen Walbrook.  At assessment it emerged that the organisation had not considered how to target students affected by socio-economic deprivation or lacking in cultural opportunities. The project was originally intended to take place between January and September 2019, tying in with Fantastic Feats and the London Design Festival. The timescale has now been pushed back, meaning that the pavilion will now be completed after the end of Fantastic Feats and will not tie in with the design festival. Feedback will be provided to allow for a more structured future proposal to be received.

15520	Asociatia Cvartetul Grazioso	10000.00	This application was looking for funding to put on a Romanian Rock Opera in the Troxy in Tower Hamlets.
			This application is for a project that will not take place in the City of London. Furthermore, the applicant organisation is not registered in the UK and therefore not eligible.
15531	CurvingRoad	12769.00	To contribute to the costs of Theatre Deli's 2020 season <i>The Future is Unwritten</i> , targeting a wide range of City audiences.
			Although there were strong elements to this project it became clear at assessment that the work may not be viable. The organisation has some financial issues to overcome before any commitment could be made to this work.
