## Appendix 2 – Programme Workstreams

## **City Cluster Vision: Phase 1 Workstreams programme**

The City Cluster Vision (adopted in May 2019) provides a framework for the transformation of the streets and public spaces over the coming decade, in order to successfully manage the projected growth within the Eastern Cluster. The goal is to deliver a world-class public realm that supports the Cluster as a thriving place to work and visit.

The long-term vision is proposed to be delivered in three phases over a period of 5-10 years. Phase One (2020-2022) will enable the implementation of an experimental timed road closure on St Mary Axe, the introduction of increased urban greening in existing public spaces and the delivery of a curated engagement programme. The proposed programme of projects reflects the views expressed during the public consultation on the City Cluster Vision and are focussed on the high priorities of the area.
