PUBLIC SUMMARY

This report summarises proposals of the Bursar of the City of London School and the Chamberlain which was processed under delegated authority by the Town Clerk, in consultation with the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Board of Governors of the City of London School, regarding applications made for hardship bursaries.

The report was restricted under Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972, paragraph 2 and 3, as it contains information which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual and as it relates to the financial information of particular persons and bodies.

Four hardship bursary applications had been submitted to the City of London School and a decision was sought as to the level of assistance, that should be offered in each case, if any.

Final recommendations were based on an assessment conducted by the Bursar and the Chamberlain of each individual case, in line with the City of London School's Bursary Guidelines. Additional input was provided by the Chairman and Deputy Chairman where there were different options available, ahead of final approval.

Summary of Recommendation(s)

All four cases were granted a bursary award of varying values, based on an assessment of their finances and personal circumstances.
