Main Report

Background

1. It was agreed, by this Board, that the appointment of all co-opted Governors would be reviewed after a period of 3 years in office. Candidates would then be given the opportunity to re-apply for their position on the Board if they so wished.
2. The last three year term of office for Sir Clive Martin came to an end on 31 December 2012. Sir Clive has since expressed a willingness to stand for re-election as a co-opted Governor on the Board.
3. Biographical details for Sir Clive Martin are attached (see Annex A) to aide the Board's decision.
4. Following discussion, the Chairman, Deputy Chairman and Headmaster have all agreed to fully support the re-appointment of Sir Clive Martin onto the Board.
