FM Conway commenced works on site on 12 June 2023 – Site clearance, strip & dispose existing track surface commenced and mostly complete to date. FM Conway is revising construction programme to verify commencement dates and periods for critical path activities i.e., floodlight and surfacing works. Track surfacing specialist (Polytan) and Lighting specialist (Halliday) have been engaged. Additional works to drainage and subsurface of the track are required to achieve compliance criteria. This means few Stakeholder requests and works to the High jump fan improvements will be affordable from the current budget and a phase 2 of the project is being considered. Anticipated construction completion – on track for October 2023.
