

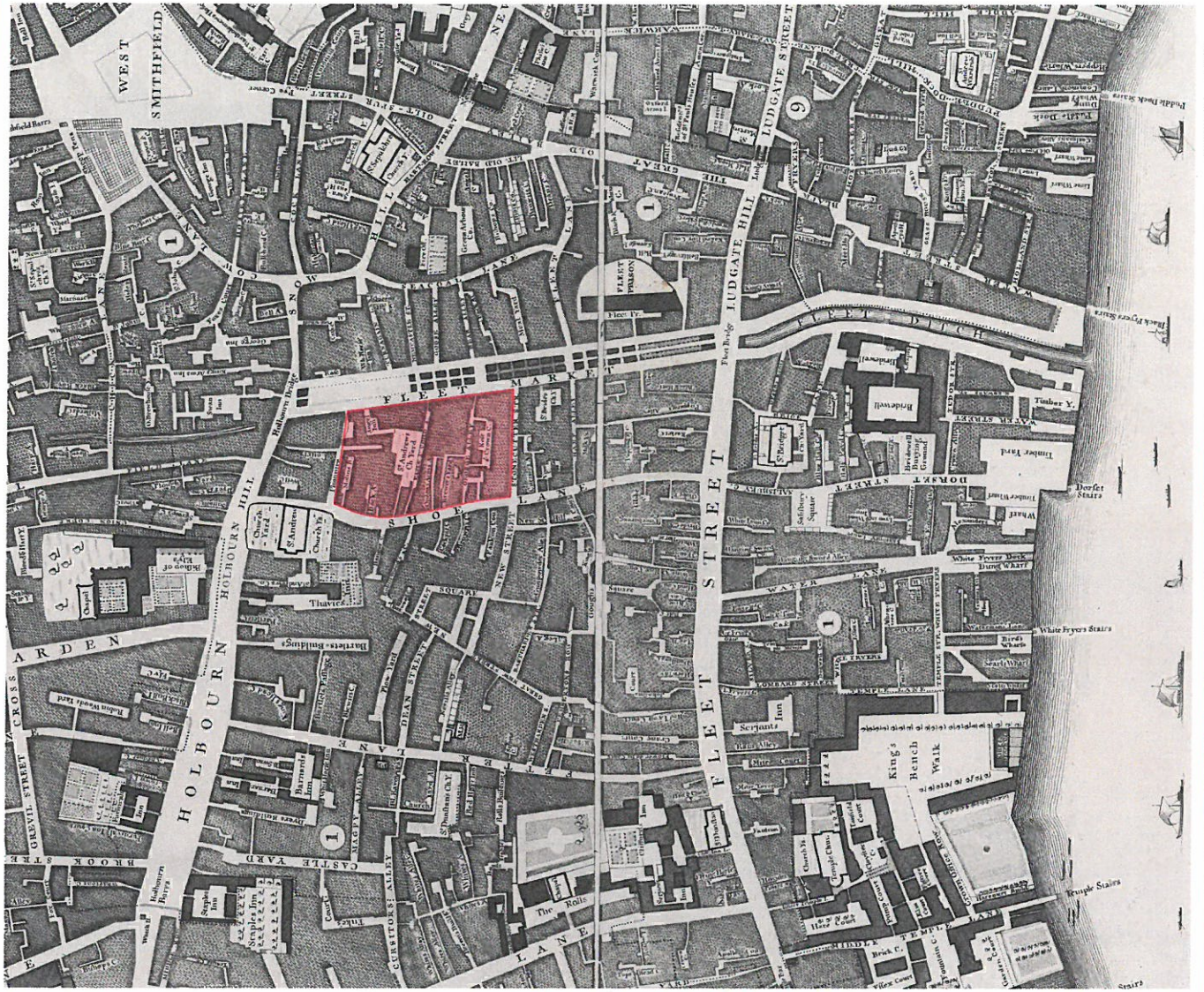

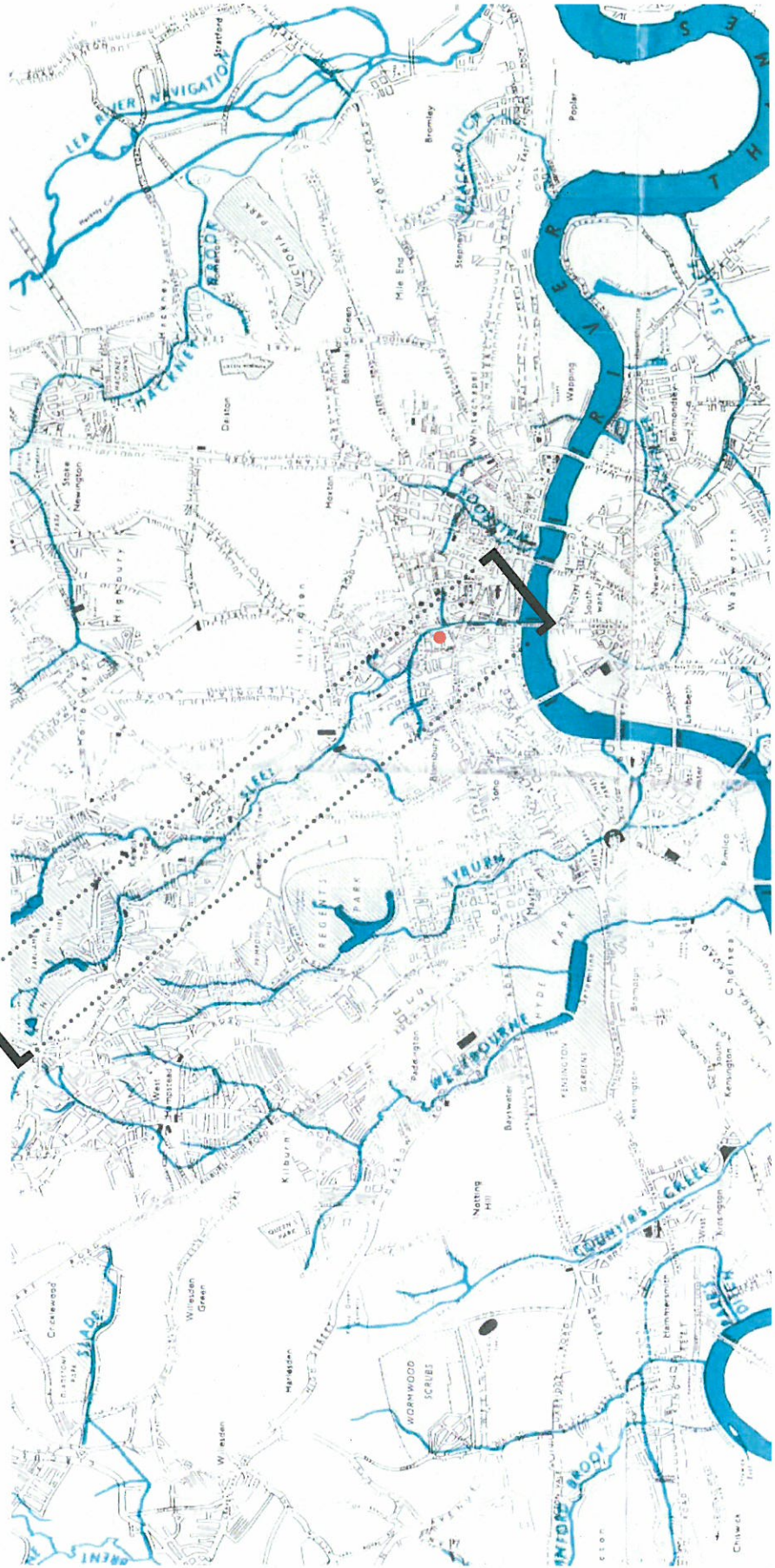

River fleet



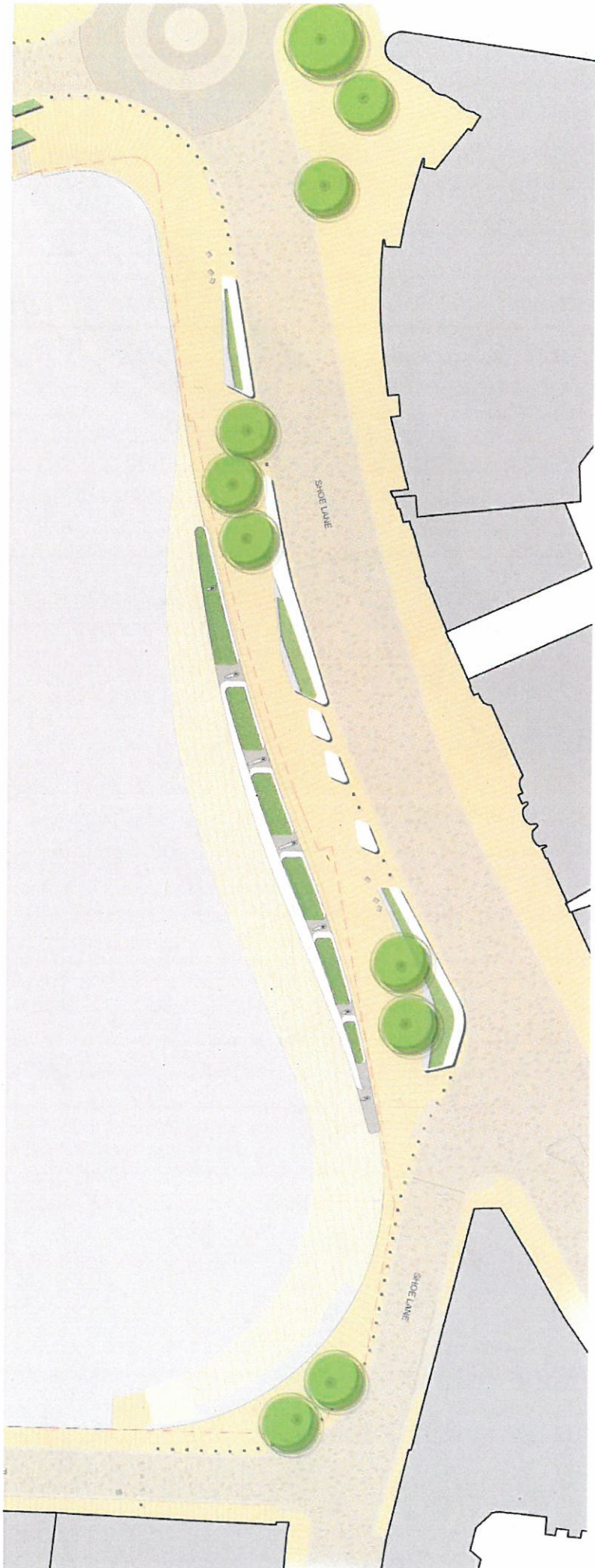




The approach to the public realm design is to firmly integrate the proposed new building into the existing urban context, creates visual coherence and provides for (pedestrian) connectivity with the wider city.



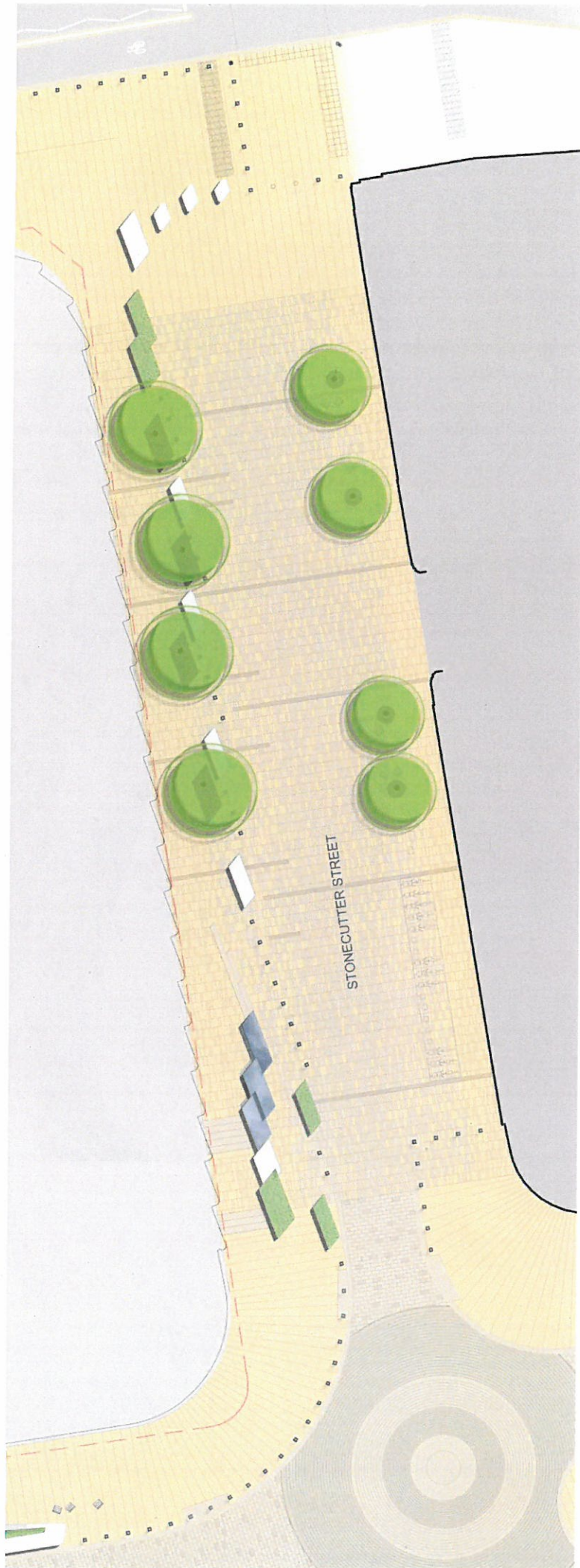














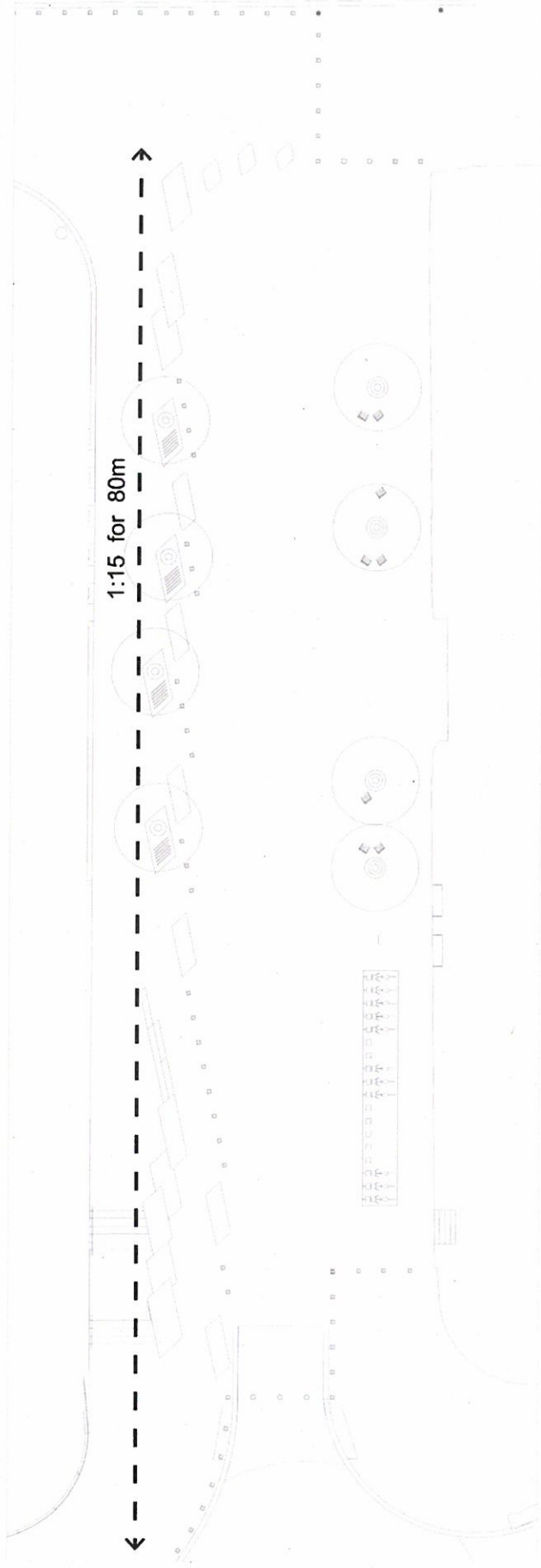




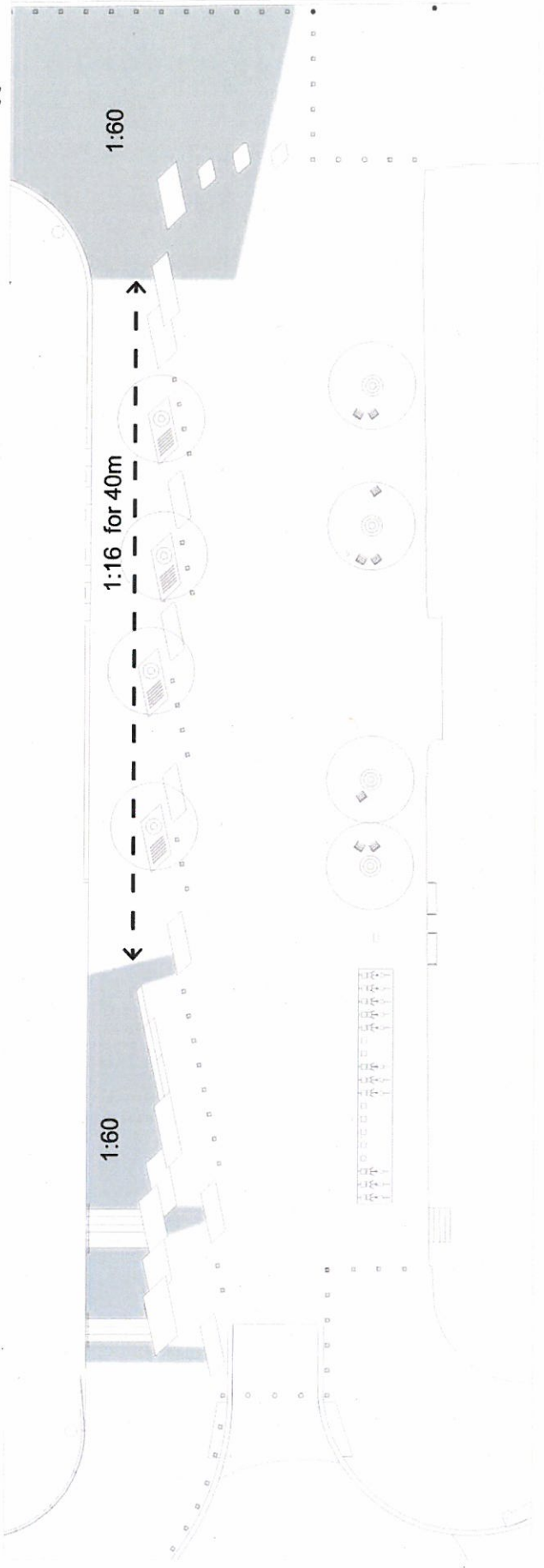




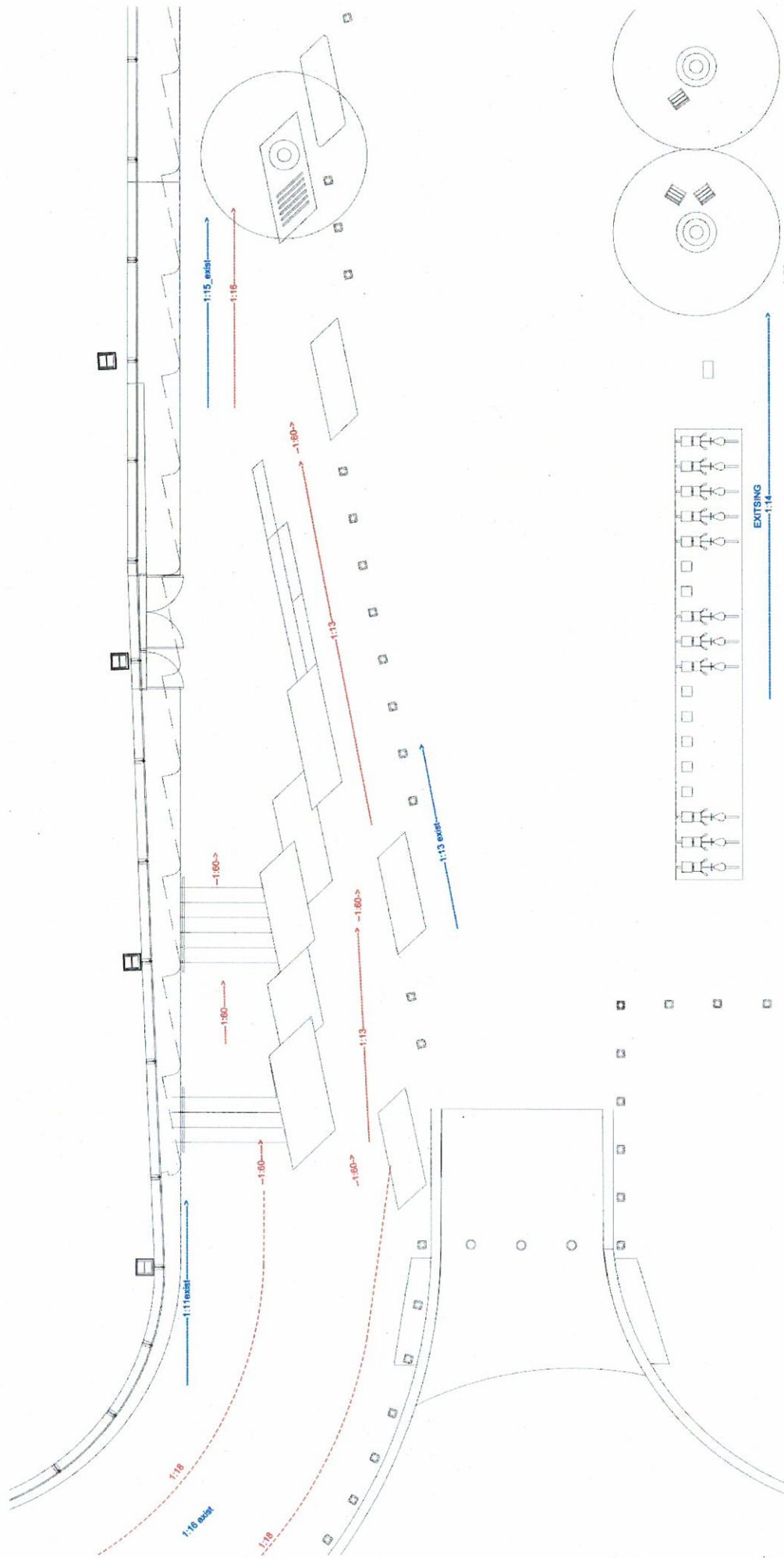


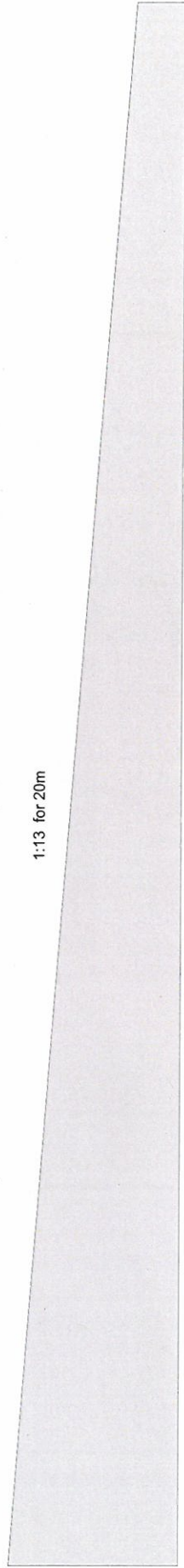

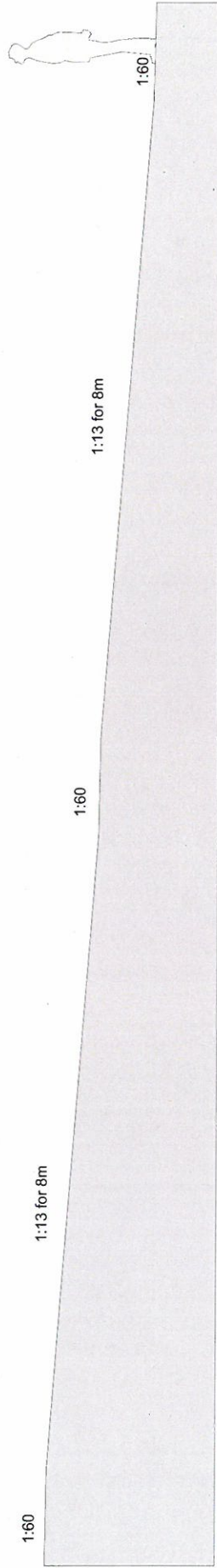


proposed gradient



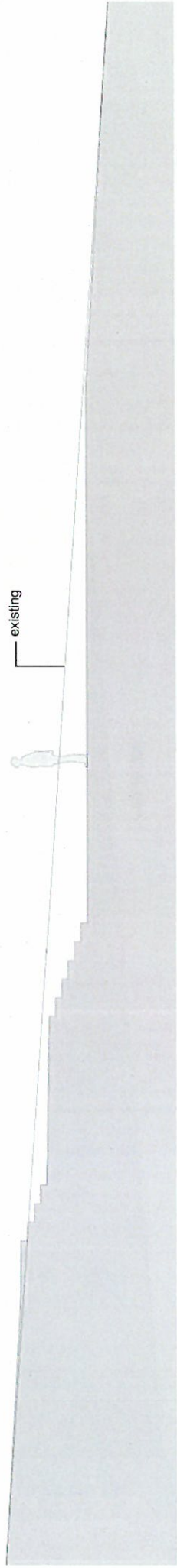
