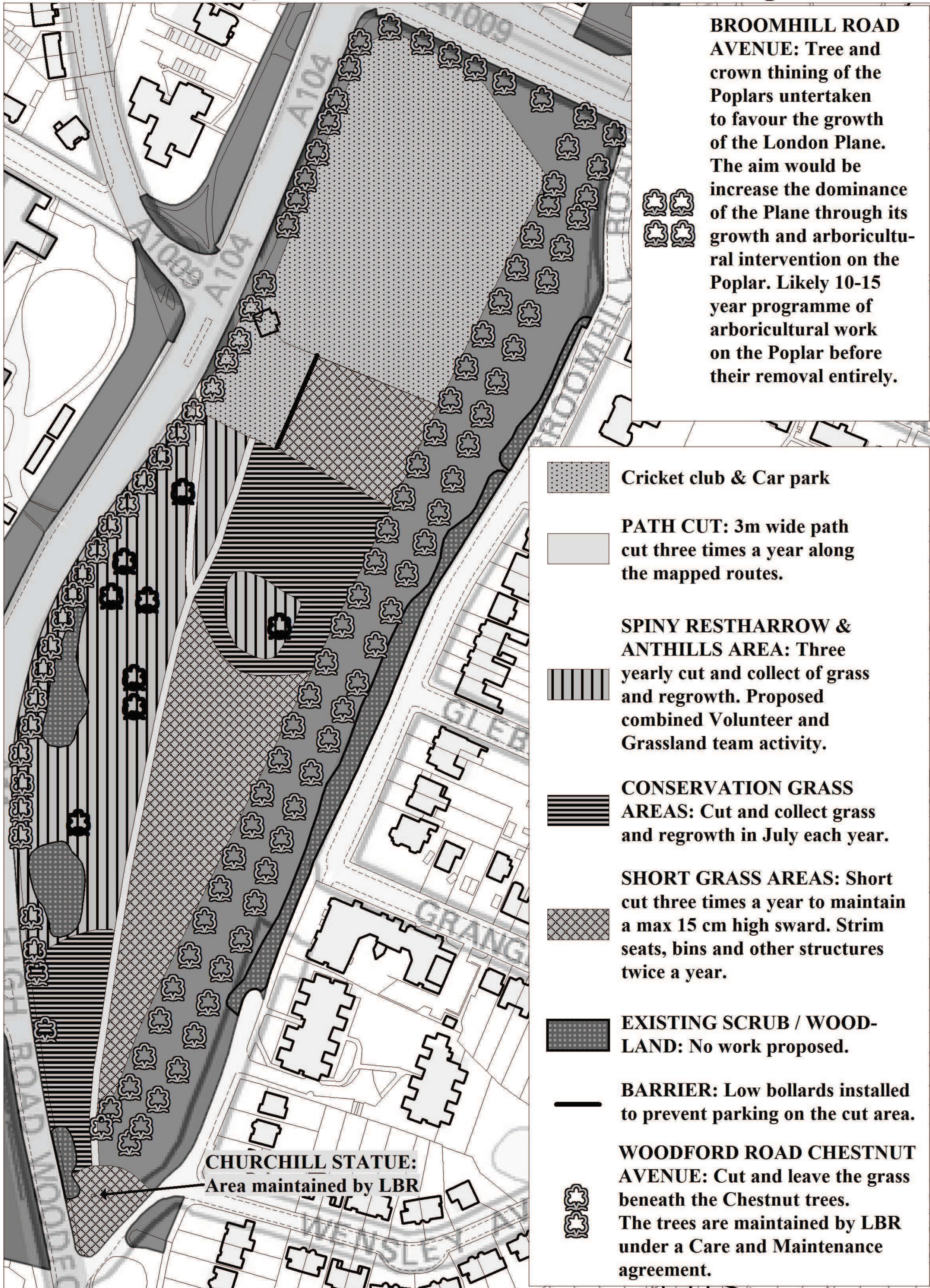
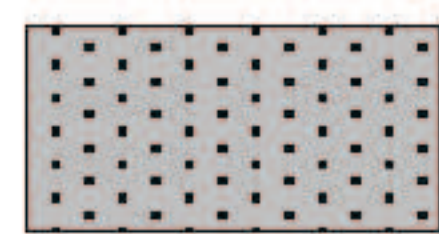


(MAP WG2) Woodford Green South: Work Proposals



BROOMHILL ROAD AVENUE: Tree and crown thinning of the Poplars undertaken to favour the growth of the London Plane. The aim would be increase the dominance of the Plane through its growth and arboricultural intervention on the Poplar. Likely 10-15 year programme of arboricultural work on the Poplar before their removal entirely.

PATH CUT: 3m wide path cut three times a year along the mapped routes.



SPINY RESTHARROW & ANTHILLS AREA: Three yearly cut and collect of grass and regrowth. Proposed combined Volunteer and Grassland team activity.



CONSERVATION GRASS AREAS: Cut and collect grass and regrowth in July each year.



SHORT GRASS AREAS: Short cut three times a year to maintain a max 15 cm high sward. Strim seats, bins and other structures twice a year.



EXISTING SCRUB / WOODLAND: No work proposed.



BARRIER: Low bollards installed to prevent parking on the cut area.



WOODFORD ROAD CHESTNUT AVENUE: Cut and leave the grass beneath the Chestnut trees. The trees are maintained by LBR under a Care and Maintenance agreement.
