

Outcome of telephone conversation with Pemberton Greenish 1<sup>st</sup> November 2013

PG will not waive privilege, and release their Counsel's opinion.

PG have not set out in clear terms what their arguments are. They have merely said in their opening letter that the issue is a legal as opposed to a technical one, and that we did not give notice; by which they must mean historic notice as opposed to notice in 2011.

Phone call ended with Ms Glanville saying she would acknowledge my 10<sup>th</sup> October letter, and confirm that their Barristers opinion would not be released. When asked what the City's response would be I stated that I would have to take instructions as to whether the City consider a meeting is appropriate.
