ANNEX A

- 1. The supply of alcohol at the premises shall only be to a person taking a meal there and for consumption by such a person as ancillary to their meal.
- 2. A direct telephone number for members of management at the premises shall be made available to local residents associations and to any person wishing to comment on the operation of the premises.
- 3. CCTV must be installed at the premises. Tapes and visual images recorded shall be retained for a period of 31 days and the system installed at the premises must be at least in accordance with the specification issued by the Licensing Authority. Access to the system must be made available to an Authorised Officer on request.
- 4. All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be in sealed containers only.
- 5. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.
- 6. Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages, including drinking water, shall be available in all parts of the premises where alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises.
- 7. A proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 21, shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence or passport.
- 8. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Council or the Police, which will record the following:
- (a) all crimes reported to the venue;
- (b) all ejections of patrons;
- (c) any complaints received;
- (d) any incidents of disorder;
- (e) seizures of drugs or offensive weapons;
- (f) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
- (g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol; or
- (h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 9. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.
