City of London Corporation Support for the 800th Anniversary of Magna Carta (inclusion of the London Copy of the Magna Carta in the Lord Mayor's Show)

Item 7 on today's agenda (City of London Corporation Support for the 800th Anniversary of Magna Carta) was also presented to the Policy and Resources Committee on 2nd October 2014. The first recommendation in this report sought approval to include the London copy of the Magna Carta in the 2014 Lord Mayor's Show, in a suitably safe and appropriate manner, at a cost not exceeding £6,000.

Policy and Resources Committee agreed the funding, as set out in the first and various other recommendations. However, the Culture, Heritage and Libraries Committee were required to give approval, in principle, to the Magna Carta being included in the Lord Mayor's Show. Arrangements for the show were well underway by 2nd October 2014 and the Culture, Heritage and Libraries Committee was not due to meet until 27th October 2014.

It was therefore agreed that the London copy of Magna Carta to be included in the 2014 Lord Mayor's Show, in a suitably safe and appropriate manner, at a cost not exceeding £6,000.
