<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Summary</u></p> <p>This report requests that Governors consider the re-appointment of Mary Robey as a co-opted Governor of the Board for a further three year-term. Ms Robey's CV is attached for information.</p> <p><u>Recommendation</u></p> <p>Governors are asked to agree the re-appointment of Mary Robey onto the Board for a further term of three years.</p>		

Main Report

Background

1. It was agreed, by this Board, that the appointment of all co-opted Governors would be reviewed after they had completed a period of 3 years in office. Candidates would then be given the opportunity to re-apply for their position on the Board if they so wished.
2. The current three year term of office for Mary Robey will come to an end in the Summer Term 2012. Ms Robey has expressed a willingness to stand for re-election as a co-opted Governor on the Board.
3. At the Board of Governors meeting in February 2010, the Chairman proposed that, rather than awaiting the expiration of a co-opted Governors term of office, re-appointments should be put to the Board of Governors, along with supporting papers, at their meeting immediately preceding the expiry of the three year term of appointment of any co-opted Governor willing to be considered for re-appointment in order to ensure continuity of service.

4. In accordance with this proposal, Governors are asked to consider the re-appointment at this meeting and a copy of Ms Robey's current CV is attached (see Annex A) to assist the Board in its decision today.
5. Following a discussion at the December 2011 Board meeting, the Town Clerk has also been asked to provide the attendance details of co-opted Governors when asking the Board to consider their re-appointment. I can report that, since her appointment to the Board in Summer 2009, Ms Robey has attended 9 out of a possible 12 Board meetings.
6. Following discussion, the Chairman, Deputy Chairman and Headmistress have all agreed to fully support the re-appointment of Ms Robey onto the Board.
7. Governors are now asked to consider Mary Robey's appointment for a further full three year term.
