Summary of Staff Training Academic Year 10/11

6. Whole staff training took place on dealing with pupils with Special Educational Needs, on differentiation, on assessment for learning, dealing with cyber-bullying and on developing pupils as independent learners. Individual teachers and small groups of staff attended INSET courses on a wide range of topics, including subject specific matters such as changing examination specifications, the use of ICT in the classroom, Child Protection and Safeguarding, delivery of Sex and Relationships Education, optimising parental engagement and First Aid.
