

Healthwatch City of London newsletter distribution

The Healthwatch City of London newsletter is distributed quarterly both electronically and in hard copy. The newsletter contains articles from City providers of health and social care, activities to get involved in, updates on concerns, initiatives undertaken by Healthwatch and gathered intelligence and feedback for readers.

744 copies were distributed of the December edition to contacts that had requested to receive the publication. 80 of these are posted and an additional 200-300 (in addition to the 744) are printed as required for meetings and events. The bulk of the distribution list is via email. Weekly email updates are distributed to the database contacts to ensure that time sensitive events are publicised. The newsletter also provides an effective branding tool for Healthwatch. In addition copies are sent to the following estate offices for further distribution:
