# **Summary**

This report introduces two applications that support the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary themes that were approved at your last meeting.

# **Main Report**

- 1. At your last meeting, you approved three themes for your 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year, for work of strategic benefit to London, over and above your usual strategic grant-making. These were:
  - Work supporting young disabled people into employment.
  - Awareness raising amongst employers about employing people with mental health problems.
  - o Future infrastructure needs of London's voluntary sector.
- 2. Two of the applications before you today support the first of these themes, namely supporting young disabled people into employment. These are:
  - Transport for All's 'Let's Get Moving' project which provides disabled young and adult Londoners with online telephone and written information and advice in regard to accessible journey-planning and travel. Lack of accessible transport is a major barrier to employment for disabled people.
  - Muscular Dystrophy Group of Great Britain and Northern Ireland's Trailblazers work-experience for young disabled Londoners.
- 3. The assessment reports of these applications have been branded with the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary logo.
