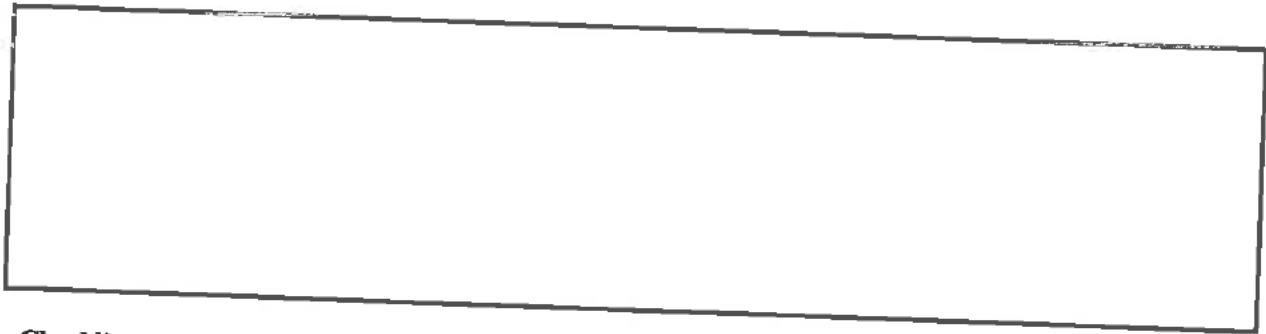
1. A suitable Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) system will be operational at the premises at all times when licensable activities are being carried out and at any other times where members of the public are present on the premises.
2. The PLH/DPS will adopt a “cooling down” period where music volume is reduced 30 minutes before the closing time of the premises.
3. A facility will be provided for customers to order Hackney taxis/private hire vehicles through members of staff.
4. All staff will receive full training on licensing.
