

Disappearing Dining Club – 26 Newbury Street  
Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. A prominent sign shall be displayed at all exits from the premises requesting that patrons leave quietly. (MC16)
2. (Taken from the amended application). The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested. (MC01)
3. (Taken from the amended application). There shall be no promoted events on the premises. A promoted event is an event involving music and/or dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the premises licence holder and/or the event is (independent of the premises licence holder) promoted to the general public.(MC02)
