The Information as to Provision of Education (England) Regulations 2016, S.I. No. 555 The Regulations amend the requirement for local authorities (including the Common Council when acting in that capacity) to report annually to the Secretary of State on the provision on schooling in their areas, so as to include additional information about capital expenditure and capacity by year group.	31 May 2016
The Licensing Act 2003 (Her Majesty The Queen’s Birthday Licensing Hours) Order 2016, S.I. No. 591 The Order permitted licensed premises to remain open until 1 a.m. from 10 to 12 June in celebration of Her Majesty’s birthday.	17 May 2016
The Private Water Supplies (England) Regulations 2016, S.I. No. 618 The Regulations consolidate, with minor amendments, the legislation regulating the quality of private water supplies for domestic use. Local authorities (including the Common Council when acting in that capacity) are principally responsible for enforcing the Regulations.	27 June 2016
