Lunchtime Reception following a march through the City by the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers to mark their 50th anniversary

An approach has been made for the City Corporation to host a lunchtime reception following a march through the City in September 2018 by the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers to mark their 50th anniversary.

The Regiment last exercised its right to march through the City in 2008 when the Colonel in Chief, the Duke of Kent was present.

The guest list is expected to include a Member of the Royal Family, the Colonel of the Regiment, serving Regular Fusiliers, serving Reserve Fusiliers, cadets, representatives from the other Privileged Regiments and Livery Companies with connections to the Regiment.

It is therefore **recommended** that hospitality be granted for a lunchtime reception for the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers and that arrangements are made under the auspices of the Hospitality Working Party; the costs to be met from City's Cash and within the approved parameters.

This would be a full court event.
