The Pollution Control Team would like to make representation to the above application for the following reasons:

The licence application does not contain adequate information to meet the licensing objective 'prevention of public nuisance' and the City of London Policy document: Statement of licensing Policy.

Namely:

The applicant should supply sufficient information as set out in the licensing policy in relation to paragraphs 33, 34, and 38 for the reasons expressed at paras 39 & 40.

This would then cover the areas where we have concerns:

The location of the premises is in close proximity residents in Laurence Pountney Hill

Information regarding dispersal policy for the premises has not been supplied.

Information regarding the location of speakers/PA systems has not been provided.

A noise management policy has not been submitted.

All appropriate steps to be taken to ensure that local residents and local businesses are not disturbed by any licensable activity at the premises are not specified.

No reference is made to the conditions for planning permission for the A3/A4 use given on 14th December 2016 which relate to preventing nuisance:

The terrace hereby permitted shall not be used or accessed between the hours of 22.00 on one day and 07.00 on the following day and 20.00 to 07.00 on Sundays or Bank Holidays, other than in the case of emergency.

No live or recorded music shall be played that it can be heard outside the premises or within any residential or other premises in the building.
