


1) Beer & Buns, 20 Bury Street, EC3A 5AX

This establishment intends to offer takeaway food/drink, which is will inevitably lead to increased noise and potential crime around the Gherkin building area/surrounding streets - ie, Creechurch Lane, where we reside. We are already suffering from the noise of people smoking/loitering outside 'Swingers' golf theme bar near the Gherkin, who are very noisy before leaving the area.
