Zebrano – Dukes Place Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1. The premises will install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested. (MC01) [Following amended application]
- 2. When a promoted event is held, SIA registered door supervisors shall be employed on a ration of 1:50 customers. [Following amended application]
- 3. At least 1 female door supervisor shall be engaged at the premises at such times as door supervisors are required to be provided. (MC06) [Following amended application]
- 4. The premises licence holder shall advise the Police of any promoted event that is to take place at the premises by completing a Risk Assessment form provided by the Police. Promoted events shall only be held on a Saturday night and the form must be submitted to the City of London Police Licensing office at least 14 working days before the event.

Promoted events may only commence on or after 18:00 on Saturday and must cease no later than 03:00 the following day. Police have the right to veto any promoted event where they consider that the licensing objectives will be undermined if it were to go ahead.

A promoted event is defined as follows:

A promoted event is an event involving music and/or dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the premises licence holder and/or the event is (independent of the licensee) promoted to the general public. (MC02) - [Following amended application]
