I have just been informed by the estate team that the Benk and Bo bakery on gravel lane have applied for an alcohol license which would permit them to serve each day up until 11pm.

As the resident of 444 petticoat square located just 2 floors directly above the shop unit I must strongly object to this being granted. We have already suffered enough of a disturbance since this unit opened such as works on the weekend prior to it opening to loud music some evenings when they host events and the clanging of the metal stair case that has been installed. These units are not fit for the purpose they propose as the are situated directly below resident properties. Every other unit closes around 8pm so its bad enough they already surpass this time more often than not.

I urge that you please strongly consider rejection of this application
