As a long time resident of Spencer Heights in Bartholomew Close, ec1a 7es, I think the 11.30pm end licence application is somewhat very out of place in this delightful and quiet residential enclave of the City. I would respectfully ask that the Licencing Authority seriously considers reducing the end time of the application.

From investigation it appears no other eating/drinking establishment in close proximity to this historic area of the City of London has such a late end time. If patrons of No 10 wish to drink later they can go to other places away from this residential area.

It seems highly selfish that one establishment can probably upset and disturb the lives of many more residents late at night than there would be patrons at No 10 at any one time.

To my knowledge no other establishment has such a late curfew.
