Summary

Main Report

Background

- 1. It was agreed, by this Board, that the appointment of all co-opted Governors would be reviewed after they had completed a period of 3 years in office. Candidates would then be given the opportunity to reapply for their position on the Board if they so wished.
- 2. The current three year term of office for Michael Bramwell, Douglas Mobsby and Councillor Chris Townsend all come to an end in early 2012 and all have expressed a willingness to stand for re-election as co-opted Governors on the Board.
- Governors are therefore asked to consider the re-appointment of all three candidates and current CVs for all are attached (see Annexes A C) to assist the Board in its decision today.
