Main Report

Background

1. It was agreed, by this Board, that the appointment of all co-opted Governors would be reviewed after they had completed a period of 3 years in office. Candidates would then be given the opportunity to re-apply for their position on the Board if they so wished.
2. The current three year term of office for Michael Bramwell, Douglas Mobsby and Councillor Chris Townsend all come to an end in early 2012 and all have expressed a willingness to stand for re-election as co-opted Governors on the Board.
3. Governors are therefore asked to consider the re-appointment of all three candidates and current CVs for all are attached (see Annexes A - C) to assist the Board in its decision today.

5. Following discussion, the Chairman and the Headmaster have agreed to fully support the re-appointment of all three candidates onto the Board.
