### Vote of Thanks to the Commissioner of the City of London Police, Ian Dyson QPM

**Resolved Unanimously:-** That, on the occasion of his retirement, Members of this Court take great pleasure in conveying to Ian Dyson QPM their gratitude and sincere appreciation for the distinguished manner in which he has carried out the role of Commissioner of the City of London Police.

In 2010, Ian joined the City of London Police as Commander and soon became Assistant Commissioner just a few years later in 2012. He was finally appointed as the 15th Commissioner of the City of London Police in 2016.

Ian's dedication to the force ensured that the City of London became the safest business district in the world. From the Miner's Strike to the Extinction Rebellion Protests, Ian's 38 years in policing have covered a plethora of significant events. His dedication to counter terrorism was reflected in the Force's response to both the 2017 London Bridge attack and the 2019 Fishmongers' Hall attack. Here, he and the force's personal commitment towards the victims and their families was inimitable.

Ian's passion for fighting economic crime saw an increased focus on obtaining local and national funding for fraud prevention as well as the expansion of available resources for the Economic Crime Directorate which enabled the creation of the post of Assistant Commissioner for Economic and Cyber Crime. Throughout his tenure, Ian collaborated with the National Police Chiefs' Council and attained the

cyber portfolio. This further highlighted the Force's specialisms for economic crime and protective security.

Equality, diversity, and inclusivity in the Force has also improved drastically throughout Ian's time as Commissioner. A renewed focus on recruitment has left the City of London Police dedicated to making change and ensuring diversity throughout the Force.

Ian has shown extreme loyalty to policing since starting his career in 1983. His devotion to crime prevention and serving his community has ensured great success for both Ian personally and for the City of London Police. Despite challenges and a constantly changing environment, Ian has always provided exemplary service which is reflected in the Force that he led.

In thanking Ian for his most distinguished service, the Court wishes to express to both Ian and Fiona their sincere wishes for a lengthy, happy and healthy retirement.

**Reports – General Purposes Committee of Aldermen**

**(i) Guidance for Liveries and Guilds – Conduct of Virtual Business**

The Court of Aldermen considered a recommendation of the General Purposes Committee of Aldermen relative to an extension to the guidance currently in place in relation to the conduct of Guild and Livery Company business until 31 October 2022.

**Guidance for Liveries and Guilds – Conduct of Virtual Business**

**Resolved Unanimously: - That:**

- i) insofar as the Ordinances or By-Laws of any Company with Livery, Company without Livery or Guild contain restrictive or prescriptive provisions as to the location and timing of any meeting, election, installation or admission of any members or officers, the Court of Aldermen agrees to allow any reasonable variation to such provisions, to be determined by the Guild or Livery company concerned and to be valid until 31 October 2022;
- ii) in particular, procedures adopted on the occasion of the binding of apprentices may be conducted virtually, subject to the requirement for the indentures to be entered within six months of the decision being taken in the Books of the Chamberlain of London;
- iii) the General Purposes Committee of Aldermen review the decision in due course and consider the future position in respect of the conduct of Guild and Livery Company business, noting that more flexible ways of working are now bedded into most business practices.

**(ii) *Revisions to the Court of Aldermen's Standing Orders***

The Court of Aldermen considered a recommendation of the General Purposes Committee of Aldermen relative to the Court's Standing Orders where revisions were now proposed to SO17 where it would be clarified that the ability for the Chairman and in their absence the Deputy Chairman to have a second or casting vote should only apply to the General Purposes Committee of Aldermen and not to the Nominations Committee, to SO20 which would clarify that the quorum for the Nominations Committee should be thirteen members, with a quorum of three members applying to the General Purposes Committee only and finally to SO33, 35 and 36 so that they might reflect the current practice in terms of the administrative process in relation to Aldermanic attendance at the Central Criminal Court.

**Resolved Unanimously:-** That the proposed revisions to the Court of Aldermen's Standing Orders and the publication of the revised Standing Orders are agreed.

## Summary

This report advises Members of action taken by the Town Clerk, in consultation with the Chairman of the Court of Aldermen, in accordance with Standing Order No. 46 (Court of Aldermen).

## Main Report

### **Applications for Freedom of the City (in the companies named)**

#### **Background and reason for urgency:**

- (i) Following the decision to postpone the meeting of the Court of Aldermen from 8th March 2022 to 30th March 2022, a number of applications for the Freedom of the City required approval under urgency.
- (ii) A deferment of consideration of the applications received could have resulted in significant inconvenience to members of the public and ultimately generate a backlog of freedom application ceremonies which would have to be managed at a later date. This enables them to be admitted to the Livery and, again, dates for this have been booked in anticipation. - (iii) Standing Order 46 states that: "Where in the opinion of the Town Clerk, urgent matters arise which require a decision before the next meeting of the relevant committee or the Court, the Town Clerk shall refer the matter to the

relevant Chairman, or in his/her absence the Deputy Chairman or in the Deputy Chairman's absence the Senior Alderman, who shall decide whether it is necessary to call a special meeting or, alternatively, to authorise the officers to act."

- (iv) The list of applications for Freedom of the City (in the Companies named) is attached. A total of 130 applications are contained therein.

**Action taken:**

- (v) In accordance with Standing Order no.46, on 1 March 2022 the Lord Mayor (on behalf of the Court of Aldermen) was consulted by the Town Clerk about the list of applications for Freedom of the City (in the companies named). Thereafter, on 2 March 2022 approval was granted by the Town Clerk for the attached list of applications for Freedom of the City (in the Companies) named and for the Clerk to the Chamberlain's Court to be instructed accordingly.
