Summary

The Terms of Reference of the Education Board allows for the appointment of up to four external representatives with appropriate expertise in the field of education. There are currently three external representatives to the Education Board, therefore a fourth representative is sought to replace Mary Robey who resigned her membership on 10 June 2024 during a term that was set to expire on 30 October 2025.

Recommendation

The Nominations Sub (Education Board) Committee is asked to agree to invite one of the applicants to join the Board as an external Member to replace Mary Robey for a term initially expiring on 30 October 2025 (renewable for a further four years), taking into account the skills and experience offered by the candidates.

Main Report

- 1. The Nominations Sub (Education Board) Committee is responsible for:
 - Reviewing the supporting statements from interested parties who wish to be considered as external members of the Education Board; and,
 - Making recommendations on the appointment of external candidates to the Education Board.

Current Position

2. Constitution of the Education Board:

A Non-Ward Committee consisting of,

- 10 Members elected by the Court of Common Council, at least two of who shall have fewer than five years' service on the Court at the time of their appointment
- Up to four external representatives, appointed by the Education Board, with appropriate expertise in the field of education (i.e. non-Members of the Court of Common Council, who shall have voting rights)
- One member appointed by the Policy & Resources Committee
- One member appointed by the Community & Children's Services Committee
