- The Head focussed on paragraph six of his report and the promising trial of the Alps which had begun to be rolled out to Heads of Departments. Alps allowed the 'value added' for any student's grades to be monitored throughout their time in Sixth Form more effectively. This contrasted as the current system which only allowed the School to calculate this data retrospectively, following completion of exams. A Governor asked whether there was any scope for the system to be applied to GCSE students. The Head explained that due to the lack of consistent data for students at Year 9 Alps was not being used for its GCSE level students, but suggested that the possibility was being considered and explored.
- Following a question from a Governor, the Head gave more detail on the pastoral reflection group. It was set up so staff could discuss their practices and learn from the counsellor how they could respond to pastoral matters. A Governor added that the Head of PSHE had also been appointed.
