I am writing to object to the application for a variation in the licence for these premises, to allow the sale of alcohol to pavement tables.

A number of residents objected to the original application to serve alcohol at pavement tables, on the grounds of the likely noise nuisance which would be caused to local residents.

Warm weather is only just beginning, since licences, allowing serving of alcohol was granted to Lino and Half Cup, in Bartholomew Close. I think it is necessary to monitor any public nuisance caused, before any other such licences are given.
