

Licensing Act 2003 Application for a Major Variation to a Premises Licence

An application has been made by WW Moor Place Ltd for major variation to a premises licence for premises at Wevorky, 1 Fore Street London EC2

The application provides for the addition of wine to the types of alcohol that may be supplied and for the 7th floor terrace area to be used for consumption of alcohol between 14.00 and 20.00 Monday to Friday.
