We noticed that an application has been posted at a cafe site on London Wall for a license 11am to 11pm 7 days a week.

I am disappointed that this license is being considered with no local resident consultation.

I object to the late opening because of the noise disturbance of people drinking and smoking outside, so close to residents in the area. Noise carries in that area, echoing off the walls of buildings in such a confined space. If a license is allowed until 11pm, then visitors to the venue will be leaving up to at least 30 mins after that – and many would likely use the podium to reach public transport.
