### Summary

This report advises Members of action taken by the Town Clerk since the last meeting of the Projects Sub-Committee, in consultation with the Chairmen and Deputy Chairmen, in accordance with Standing Order Nos. 41(a) and (b).

### Main Report

#### **Delegated Authority – Gateway 1/2/3/4/5 City Streets: Transportation Response to support COVID-19 Recovery (Phase 2) [9 June 2020]**

1. The Town Clerk approved a sum of £1,048,744 as a design and implementation budget for phases 1 and 2 and noted that the total estimated cost of the COVID-19 Transportation project was not yet known given the scope of later phases. The project involves temporary traffic management measures be implemented on City Streets in response to COVID-19 to provide safer spaces for people walking and cycling, and queuing outside shops and offices to socially distance and support businesses in their return to work. The project consists of street changes to provide additional space for people walking and cycling. These will first be installed using signs, lines and barriers to allow for easy adaption if required. This will be delivered in a phased approach. On street changes will be delivered alongside measures to support businesses, manager travel demand, and encourage travel on foot, cycle and public transport. The Town Clerk noted that project funding was predicated on securing significant grant funding from central government and Transport for London.
