



Relevant Local Plan Policies

CS12 Conserve or enhance heritage assets

To conserve or enhance the significance of the City's heritage assets and their settings, and provide an attractive environment for the City's communities and visitors.

REASON: To ensure the protection of the special architectural or historic interest of the building in accordance with the following policy of the Local Plan: DM12.3.
- The listed gates shall be reinstated in accordance with the drawings hereby approved, or as approved under conditions of this consent, prior to the first occupation of any part of the development approved under planning permission 20/00671/FULEIA.

 REASON: To ensure that the Local Planning Authority may be satisfied with the detail and to protect the special architectural and historic

- interest of the building in accordance with the following policies of the Local Plan: DM 10.1, DM 12.1, DM12.3
