## CONDITIONS

- 1 The works hereby permitted must be begun before the expiration of three years from the date of this consent.  
REASON: To ensure compliance with the terms of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
  
- 2 Before any works thereby affected are begun the following details shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and all works pursuant to this consent shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details:
  - (a) a full survey and photographic record of the Obelisk and associated plaque prior to dismantling;
  - (b) details of a method statement for dismantling the Obelisk, to include full survey and photographic record of dismantling, protection and labelling of individual elements, secure storage and details of materials;
  - (c) a full survey and photographic record and report of the Obelisk during dismantling, including any foundations or associated below ground structures;
  - (d) details of a condition survey and any proposals arising from the surveys, including details of cleaning, conservation and consolidation work identified;
  - (e) details of a method statement for the reconstruction of the Obelisk to include details of materials, particulars and samples of any new materials, mortar samples;
  - (f) details of any new foundations and below ground works including new mortars and mortar samples and junctions with the Obelisk;
  - (g) details of any conservation or other work to the engraved lettering on the Obelisk;
  - (h) details of interpretation and information about Robert Waithman and the Obelisk memorial;

REASON: To ensure the protection of the significance and setting of the listed structure and that the Local Planning Authority may be satisfied with the detail of the proposed works and to ensure a satisfactory external appearance in accordance with the following policies of the Local Plan: CS12, DM12.4.

- 3 The works hereby permitted shall not be carried out other than in accordance with the following approved drawings and particulars or as approved under conditions of this consent.

REASON: To ensure that the development of this site is in compliance with details and particulars which have been approved by the Local Planning Authority.
