Update on NQT/ECT Policy

From September 2021, newly qualified teachers (NQTs) will be referred to as early career teachers (ECTs) who have an entitlement to an early career framework (ECF). Training for the changes is taking place in late June. Therefore, the current NQT policy requires a complete re-write which will take place after the training. The new ECT policy will come to the October Board for final approval.
