Summary

Main Report

1. Since the last meeting of the Committee, approval was given to one item under urgency procedures or delegated authority arrangements, pursuant to Standing Order No. 41, as follows:-

Mayor of London - Let's Do London

- 2. The City Arts Initiative (CAI) received a public art application from the GLA as part of the Let's Do London activation programme. For the upcoming Family Fun season, Design In Air have produced inflatable eyeballs which will be illuminated and suspended in trees across the Central Activities Zone. This installation will be a signature feature for the Family Fun season, helping to drive footfall to Central London and supporting the full and safe re-opening of London's economy. The City Arts Initiative is supportive of the project and it is to be fully funded by the Mayor of London. Site visits with City Corporation officers have taken place and three potential locations have been identified in the City.
- An urgent decision was sought and obtained so that the City of London could be referenced in forthcoming press announcements by the Mayor of London on Wednesday 14 July, before the next Committee meeting, scheduled for 19 July 2021.
