# **Conditions Applied to Licences Granted by way of Delegated Authority**

## **Fazenda**

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.

### **UKI Two**

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
- 2. Promoted events will not be held at the premises. A promoted event is an event involving music and dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the licensee (premises licence holder) and the event is (independent of the licensee) promoted to the general public.

# **Neat Meat**

- 1. A comprehensive CCTV system shall be installed and maintained at the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon request of Police or authorized officer of any responsible authority.
- 2. All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be sold in sealed containers, except that to be consumed at the seating outside the premises.
- 3. Consumption of alcohol outside the premises shall cease at 22:30 hours.
- 4. Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

# **Centre Pizza**

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street

environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.

### MSU2A

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
- 2. Promoted events will not be held at the premises. A promoted event is an event involving music and dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the licensee (premises licence holder) and the event is (independent of the licensee) promoted to the general public.
- 3. An incident log shall be kept at the premises and made available on request to the Police or an authorised officer of the City of London Corporation. The log will record the following:
- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) all ejections of customers
- (c) any incidents of disorder (disturbance caused either by one person or a group of people)

[There is no requirement to record the above incidents (a), (b) or (c) where they do not relate to a licensable activity]

- (d) seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
- (e) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
- (f) any refusal of the sale of alcohol during the hours the premises is licensed to sell
- 4. The Licence holder shall make available a contact telephone number to nearby residents and the City of London Licensing Team to be used in the event of complaints arising.
- 5. Prominent signage shall be displayed at all exits from the premises requesting that customers leave quietly.
- 6. A written dispersal policy shall be in place and implemented at the premises to move customers from the premises and the immediate vicinity in such a way as to cause minimum disturbance or nuisance to neighbours.

## The Sky Residences - Residents Lounge

- 1. The public shall not be admitted to the premises, access to licensable activities will only be provided for residents of The Sky Residences and their bona fide guests, and employees of the premises licence holder and their guests.
- 2. A CCTV system shall be maintained covering at least the Level 20 Concierge area, the library and lounge. Images recorded shall be retained for at least 31 days. Police and authorised officers of the licensing authority shall be allowed access to live and recorded images provided such requests are made in accordance with the Data Protection Act/GDPR as appropriate. Copies of recorded images authorised for release as above will be made available within 48 hours.

# **Starbucks**

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
- 2. The licence holder shall ensure that all staff are trained to ask any customer attempting to purchase alcohol, who appears to be under the age of 21 years (or older if the licence holder so elects) for evidence of age. This evidence shall be photographic, such as passport or photographic driving licence until other effective identification technology (for example, thumb print or pupil recognition) is introduced. All staff will be instructed, through training, that a sale shall not be made unless this evidence is produced.

#### Uncorked

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public entry and exit points will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
- 2. There shall be no sale of alcohol in unsealed containers for consumption off the premises.
- **3**. There shall be no on-sales of alcohol before 10:00 hours on any day.
- **4**. The delivery of alcohol shall be only made to a residential or business address, where the customer uses that address as an official place of residence or their recognised designated place of work. The delivery of alcohol shall not be made or completed in a public place (on the street, in a park, by the bus stop, etc.).

## **Mediabrands**

- :1. The general public shall not be admitted to the premises, access to licensable activities will only be provided for employees of the premises licence holder, agents, servants and invited guests.
- 2. A CCTV system shall be maintained covering entrances, lift lobbies and reception. Images recorded shall be retained for at least 31 days. Police and authorised officers of the licensing authority shall be allowed access to live and recorded images provided such requests are made in accordance with the Data Protection Act/GDPR as appropriate. Copies of recorded images authorised for release as above will be made available within 48 hours.
- 3. Alcohol sold for consumption outside of 16 Old Bailey shall be in sealed containers.

## **Shiro**

All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition.
