Conditions Applied to Licences Granted by way of Delegated Authority

Naniwa

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
2. A Challenge 25 policy shall be enforced, where any person reasonably looking under the age of 25 shall be asked to prove their age when attempting to purchase alcohol; signs to this effect shall be displayed at the premises. The only acceptable forms of identity shall be those photographic identification documents recognised in the Home Office guidance; including passports, photo-card driving licence or proof of age card bearing a PASS hologram.
3. Alcohol shall only be served as an off-sale for service to people seated at the tables to the front of the premises.

Donburi

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.

Farm Originals

1. There shall be no sale of alcohol in unsealed containers for consumption off the premises.
2. All doors and windows shall remain closed at all times hours for save for entry or exit, or in the event of an emergency.

3. A written dispersal policy shall be in place and implemented at the premises to move customers from the premises and the immediate vicinity in such a way as to cause minimum disturbance or nuisance to neighbours.

4. Prominent signage shall be displayed at all exits from the premises requesting that customers leave quietly.

5. Customers permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises e.g. to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.

6. The Licence holder shall make available a contact telephone number to nearby residents and the City of London Licensing Team to be used in the event of complaints arising.

7. The premises will install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.

WHSmith

1. All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be in sealed containers only, and shall not be consumed on the premises.

2. A CCTV system is installed within the premises. Copies of recordings will be kept for 31 days and made available to the Licensing Authority or Responsible Authorities upon request.

Tilney, Smith & Williamson

1. The premises shall maintain a comprehensive CCTV system covering the premises licence holders reception areas, lift lobbies and stairwell access points enabling facial identification of every person in any lighting condition. Between 07.30 and 18.00 Monday to Friday, Police and authorised officers of the licensing authority shall be allowed access to live and recorded images of the CCTV system within the demise of the premises licence holder provided such requests are made in accordance with the Data Protection Act/GDPR as appropriate. Copies of recorded images authorised for release shall be made available within 2 working days.

2. There shall be no sale of alcohol in unsealed containers for consumption off the premises.

Island Poke

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public.

Leadenhall Market

1. Any sound checks shall be undertaken between the hours of 08:00-23:00 on the day of the event.
2. At all times during the operational hours of the site, including periods of set up, maintenance or housekeeping a phone number shall be available to contact the site. This number shall be notified to the licencing authority and premises neighbouring the site. The contact must be on site and of a seniority to control operations at all times the site is operational.
3. An event management plan approved by the licensing authority shall be in place and implemented to ensure that licensing objectives are met. The plan will need to include how performers noise levels are controlled and how guests are managed when they leave the premises to cause minimum disturbance or nuisance to neighbours.
4. A comprehensive digital CCTV system will be in place and accessible for the duration of the event.
5. Security arrangements to control access and egress to the event area are to be agreed with the City of London Police prior to the event taking place.

Café St James

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open for licensable activities and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open for licensable activities. This staff member shall be able to show the police or the Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.
2. Promoted events will not be held at the premises. A promoted event is an event involving music and dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the licensee (premises licence holder) and the event is (independent of the licensee) promoted to the general public.
3. There shall be no sale of alcohol in unsealed containers for consumption off the premises after 22:00 hours.

Fazenda

1. There shall be no sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
2. All outside tables and chairs shall be rendered unusable by 23.00 hours each day.
3. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment, will be covered enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually records whilst the premises are open to the public and recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public. This staff member shall be

able to show the police or Licensing Authority recordings of the preceding two days immediately when requested.

4. Promoted events will not be held at the premises. A promoted event is an event involving music and dancing where the musical entertainment is provided at any time by a disc jockey or disc jockeys one or some of whom are not employees of the licensee (premises licence holder) and the event is (independent of the licensee) promoted to the general public.

Mazars

1. The provision of licensable activities shall be restricted to: employees and officers of the organisations in occupation, or their associated companies; and bona fide guests of the said employees, officers and companies; and persons attending any bona fide private event at the premises.

2. CCTV will be installed and maintained at the premises and made available on request to an authorised officer.

Laduree

1. The supply of alcohol will be by table service only.

2. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. Recordings will be made available to the police or the Licensing Authority when requested.

WeWork

1. The supply of alcohol shall only be to members of the Wework group of companies or employees of member companies, or their bona fide guests.

2. No drinks or glassware shall be taken outside the premises.

3. Prominent signage shall be displayed at all exits from the premises requesting that customers leave quietly.
