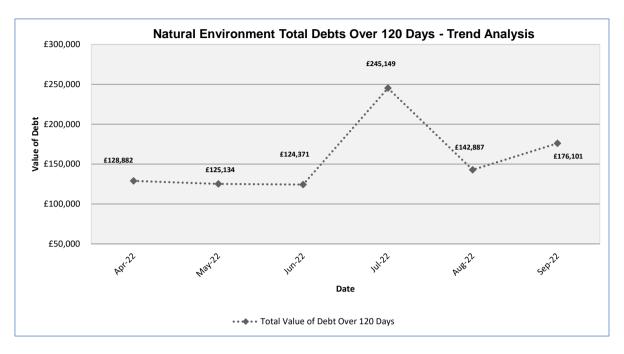
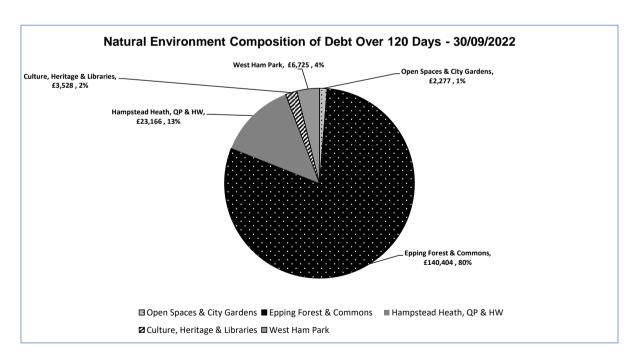
Natural Environment - Outstanding Invoiced Debts - September (Period 6)
