Grounds for objection:

I am a resident of the Levett Building (my address is [REDACTED] Levett Building, Barts Square, Little Britain, EC1A 7BR). Therefore I am a neighbour to the address cited in the premises licence application. I believe a late night licence would be disastrous in the middle of a residential area where many people live peacefully. Therefore I object on the grounds of preventing public nuisance and maintaining public safety. We have two young children and we chose to live in this area due to its peaceful ambience. It is within a short walking distance from bars and restaurants but we never envisaged that a 3am licence would be granted right underneath the building. Granting this licence would lead to drunken, noisy and disruptive behaviour right on the doorstep of many people's homes.
