My reason is that I bought the flat as it is a quiet residential area where I can work and sleep well. I think this will be substantially eroded if this planning were to be given. St Barts was supposed to be a lovely place to live , with pleasant cafes and restaurants and where we could sit under the leafy trees and be at peace.

I don't want late drinkers , shouting, singing or vomiting in St Barts , this would be a tragedy. Drug use would also increase and the police activity on stretched resources would also need increasing .
