I am writing to object to the proposed license changes applied for by the University of Chicago Business School at 1 Bartholomew Close.

Bartholomew Close is a quiet residential area of the City and the suggestions they should be allowed to serve alcohol on and off the premises until 3am 7 days a week are utterly inappropriate given the local character of the area. As is the proposal to allow live music until late.
